Wantanawe



The notation doesn't capture the slow swing feel of the melody.

Doesn't mean anything, but the sentiment is to stop defining everything. Hence... words that don't mean anything.

- 1. Watanawe Toowaguwa: Sway R, L, R, then left foot steps in front and to the Right, as in a half grapevine. Rep four times... emphasize the fourth repeat as the step changes there.
- 2. On Toowaguwa it's three slow steps in leading with left foot (L, R, L), then four slow steps out leading with right foot (R, L, R, L,) ending ready to sway R on beginning of phrase. Dancers can flow right into the step by changing the last sway where the Left foot steps in into stepping forward.
