We are so excited to welcome you all to the Lava Hot Springs Peace Dance !

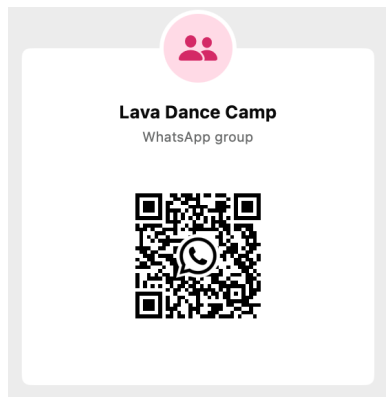
We can't wait to dance together under our main tent up in the trees near Lava.

🚗 Arrival

Communication: Please join the Whatsapp group here so you can chat with us if you need directions.



GPS should do a good job of getting you out to the ranch.

The turn into the cabin is sharp and over a small bridge. If you are towing a trailer be sure to take a wide turn.

We'll have flags hanging off a tree branch and signs.

Most of the camping spots are an immediate right turn down a small roadway.

Wayne, Zareen, JJ and Glenn and the regular gang will be somewhere milling about. Find us and we'll help you locate a spot. We would like most of the parking to be down in the lower field. It'll be good to park snuggled together so everyone can fit.

Camping & Accommodations

RVs & Campers: We have fairly flat spots dug out for campers and vans. Wayne, Zareen and JJ will help you find a spot.

Tent Campers: There are lots of hidden tent sites snuggled around the property. You may want to plan on a short hike after you arrive so you can find your own perfect spot. Many of the tent spots have room for your car to be nearby.

Off-site Options: If you aren't camping, the event site is just a little over 6 miles from town, where you can find plenty of motels, restaurants, and grocery stores.

If you are looking for an AirBnB select one to the south of town and you'll be even closer.

Cell Phone coverage: There is good cell service at the cabin. Wayne and Zareen will also have a Starlink set up if anyone needs more.

Arrival Times and Tent Setup

Wayne and Zareen will be at the site on Sunday. We expect the first campers to arrive on Wed. July 15th.

Early Arrivals: If you are coming earlier, please let us know.

Tent Setup: will be on Monday the 13th. We'll be decorating and all the rest of the week.

Pets & Property Rules

Animals: Pets are welcome, but they must be kept on a leash.

Clean and Tidy: The cabin property we are camping on is co-owned by Kim's family. It's important that we leave it in better condition than we find it.

Fire Danger is high this year. Please no candles, incense or smoking in tents off in the trees. We expect each attendee to know and practice best camping practices for dry conditions.

Weather & Packing Tips

Heat: Lava Hot Springs is experiencing the same weather conditions as the rest of the country – HOT. However, our camping spot is at 6k feet up in the cool trees. You can expect our temperature to be 10 degrees cooler than Lava at any time.

The afternoons will be warm. The cabin stays nice and cool, so we'll gather there in the heat.

We could see 60 degrees in the morning and 80 in the afternoons.

Food & Cooking:

No meals are provided, so please bring your own food and the gear you need to cook it. There is a kitchen in the cabin we can share for individual cooking and group meals.

The cabin has electricity.

No group meals are planned but they are certainly encouraged! Anyone who wants to organize can do so. We do ask that a high level of food safety be observed.

There is one refrigerator to share. It'll get pretty full!
